Performances will take place in the Mansfield High School Auditorium on Friday, November 17th at 7 pm and Saturday, November 18th at 1 pm and 7 pm.

This magical play (with music) is the prequel to the century old story of J.M Barrie's legendary Peter Pan. A wildly theatrical adaptation of Dave Barry and Ridley Pearson's bestselling novel, the play was conceived for the stage by director Roger Rees and Alex Timbers and written by Rick Elice, with music by Wayne Barker.

From marauding pirates and jungle tyrants to unwilling comrades and an unlikely hero, Peter and the Starcatcher playfully explores the depths of greed and despair, and the bonds of friendship, duty, and love. A young orphan and his mates are shipped off from Victorian England to a distant island ruled by the evil King Zarboff. They know nothing of the mysterious trunk in the captain's cabin, which contains a precious otherworldly cargo. At sea, the boys are discovered by a young girl named Molly, a starcatcher in training who realized that the trunks precious cargo is Starstuff, a celestial substance so powerful that it must never fall into the wrong hands.

Mansfield High School's production of Peter and the Starcatcher features twenty one student actors and actresses who play over one hundred characters.
