[Coding Day at Bristol Community College](#)

Mrs. Elofson's students enjoyed a stimulating and informative day of coding on May 30th at Bristol Community College in Attleboro.

In the Game Design workshop, students created their own games using a simple visual programming language called Kodu. During the Cybersecurity session, students witnessed in real time how quickly companies track your every move on the internet and learned how this data is collected, sold and often stolen for financial gain, and also discussed careers in cybersecurity. Finally, during the workshop on

Computer Forensics, students teamed up and put their sleuthing and technical skills to the test to uncover evidence left behind by a "criminal mastermind."
